

# The Background....

ith understandable differences for dramatic licence, the story of Maria Rainer follows quite closely the real life story which was enacted in the Villa Trapp at Aigen-bei-Salzburg. Maria had completed the State Teachers' Course for Progressive Education and had entered the beautiful Nonnberg Abbey as a postulant waiting for the time when she would be received into the Novitiate. Then, on the instructions of the Mother Abess, she took the twenty minute bus ride to the Villa Trapp which completely changed her life.

After her marriage to Captain Von Trapp and the birth of two daughters, world events including the Anschluss in 1938 when Austria was annexed by Nazi Germany brought about yet another major upheaval. The whole family, under the subterfuge of mountain climbing in the South Tyrol, managed to escape from their beloved Austria, and eventually made their way to America. After six months and the birth of a baby boy, the family was told that no extension could be granted to their temporary stay permits and sadly they had to leave, embarking on a concert tour of Scandinavia and Holland. They eventually obtained visas for a further six months visit to America arriving back in October 1939 only to be confined on Ellis Island for 5 days before clearance was given for them to stay.

The rest of the story is now history as the family, living very frugally indeed, built up their reputation with concert tours, being accepted as candidates for U.S. citizenship, and finally settling in a permanent home in Stowe, Vermont. It was here that Captain von Trapp died in 1947, but the von Trapp Family Singers continued to tour the world giving concerts.

In 1950 they returned to Austria and visited their old house which, immediately after their departure, had been looted and taken over by the Nazis as the Headquarters of Heinrich Himmler. After the war the family sold the house to an American religious Order who wished to establish a Seminary in Europe.

Maria died in 1987 aged 82 and was laid to rest alongside her husband on the family property in Stowe, Vermont.
